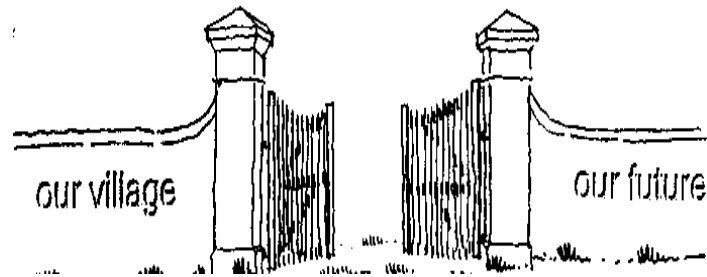


Culworth in Ten Years



Questions, questions

Yes, our village plan people are asking your opinion again. There was a really good turnout for the village day, when we managed to group suggestions and problems into six areas. Now the village has been given a grant (yes, some money from the government!!) to find out a bit more, and produce a plan for the village, so we are asking everyone over the age of 10 living in the village to answer some more questions.

Some of the questions might seem a bit personal, but all the information is anonymous, and there are good reasons why asking about where you live, how you travel, what village services you use, or have problems with. What you say might mean, for example, that we arrange another mobile library stop, if enough people in one part of the village want to use it, or it could affect the siting of bins, recycling facilities, tree planting... But if there is a question that you really don't want to answer, just leave it blank.

To save paper there is only questionnaire to each household. One person for the whole household should fill in the first part, headed HOUSEHOLD SECTION. The next part, headed PERSONAL SECTION, has room for six people to answer questions about themselves. If you have more people than that in the house, or if someone doesn't want everyone else to see what he or she thinks, ask your collector for another questionnaire. (We would rather you didn't unless you need to – they cost money to produce.) Your collector will also be happy to help you if there are any questions that you don't understand, want to volunteer to help with something (we would be delighted to hear from you), or would like some more information about the village plan.

Please take the time to read through the questions carefully and to fill in your own column - always column 1 for person one, always column 2 for person two and so on. Some questions ask for a code number to be put in the columns rather than a straightforward tick these questions are marked with a *

Once you have filled this in, the researchers will put all the data into a computer, press a few buttons, and discover what it is that everyone in Culworth really wants. Further information will be put on the village plan website at <http://freespace.virgin.net/culworth.plan>, and the report will be published once it is ready.

If you feel strongly about any issue that isn't fully covered in the questions, please add additional comments at the end of the questionnaire.
